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**J.J. NEILSON FAMILY ENDOWMENT FUND**

**Conditions:**

1. Recipients of awards will be chosen each year by an Awards Committee composed of:
  - a. the Principal, Arnprior District High School;
  - b. The Head of Student Services, Arnprior District High School;
  - c. the Trustees representing the area served by Arnprior District High School; and
  - d. the Superintendent
2. To be eligible for an award a student must:
  - a. have attended Arnprior District High School for a minimum of two full academic years (6 credits per year);
  - b. have obtained the Ontario Secondary School Diploma and a minimum of 6 university entrance courses;
  - c. apply for an award prior to June 15<sup>th</sup> each year and provide proof that they are enrolled in one of the following university undergraduate or first professional degree programs. Graduate programs (masters or doctorates) are not eligible.

(1) Medical Doctor	(5) Physical Therapy
(2) Dentistry	(6) Nursing Science
(3) Optometry	(7) Pharmacy
(4) Occupational Therapy	(8) Dietetics/Nutrition
3. Students enrolled in a Medical Faculty will have first priority for awards.
4. The Selection Committee shall determine the recipients. The Selection Committee may consider the following criteria when considering applications:
  - a. Academic Record;
  - b. Citizenship;
  - c. Financial Need; and
  - d. Participation in School and Community Activities.
5. The maximum award per student shall be limited to 25% of the income from the estate for the year. A student may receive a maximum of 4 awards. Any income not awarded in a given year shall be retained and awarded in the subsequent years.
